**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT POLICIES AT CITY OF VINTON
BRUSH DUMP AND COMPOST PILE**


WHEREAS, the City of Vinton owns and operates a brush dump and compost pile on Highway 150 north of the Cedar River, and

WHEREAS, the City Council feels certain policies should be in place to regulate the activity at the brush dump and compost pile.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Vinton, that the following policies are to be posted and followed at the City's brush dump and compost pile:


1. Use of the brush dump and compost pile is free of charge for residents of the city of Vinton and Benton County as well as county employees acting in the employment of Benton County.
2. Everything must be emptied from containers (i.e. bags, buckets, etc.) and containers must be taken off site. Bags can be disposed at compost site in approved garbage cans.
3. Sticks/vines/brush must be separated from grass and leaves.
4. Only one large load (i.e. pickup/dump truck) of compost per day per individual/business.
5. No compost is to be taken for any "fill" uses such as around a building or in a ditch.
6. Compost site may be closed due to weather (snow) and/or high water from Cedar River flooding.
