CHAPTER 167
LICENSING OF SEWER AND WATER SERVICE INSTALLERS

167.01 License Required

167.02 Sewer and Water Service Installer's
Licenses

167.01 LICENSE REQUIRED. No person, firm or corporation shall engage in the construction, reconstruction, laying, alteration, repair, removal, or capping off of a sanitary sewer service pipe, water service pipe or building sewer or water pipe in the City, without first having a Master Plumber's License or a Sewer and Water Service Installer's License in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.

167.02 SEWER AND WATER SERVICE INSTALLER'S LICENSES.

1. Application. Application for a sewer and water service installer's license shall be made to the Clerk on forms furnished by the City and a license shall be issued in accordance with the following:

A. Insurance Required. Each applicant shall file a certificate of insurance indicating that the applicant is carrying public liability insurance in effect for the duration of the license, covering the acts of the licensee, the licensee's agents and employees; and the City shall be named as additional insured; for the following minimum amounts: The policy shall also provide for at least ten (10) days notice by the insurer to the City of termination of the policy by the insured or insurer.

B. License Fees. Before issuance of a license, a license fee shall be paid. The fees for examination and license shall be established by resolution of the Council.

C. Examination. No sewer and water service installer's license shall be issued until the applicant has successfully passed the examination given by the Board or City Coordinator. Any person who fails to pass the sewer and water service installer's examination must wait a minimum of 30 days before retesting.

2. License Expiration and Renewals. Every license which has not previously been revoked shall expire on December 31 of each year and may be renewed annually upon payment of the license fee. Expired licenses may be renewed without reexamination within a reasonable time.

3. Interpretation. A sewer and water service installer's license shall not be construed as a license or permit to do plumbing work as a Journeyman Plumber or a Master Plumber in the City. A building sewer service is that part of the drainage system which extends from the end of the building drain and conveys its discharge to a public sewer, private sewer, individual sewage-disposal system, or other point of disposal. A water service extends from the water main to the building water meter.
