<u>77.01 PURPOSE</u>. The purpose of this chapter is to approve the operation of golf carts on the streets of the City.

77.02 OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS PERMITTED. Golf carts may be operated upon the streets of the City by persons possessing a valid driver's license, except as prohibited in Section 77.03 of this chapter.

77.03 PROHIBITED STREETS. Golf carts shall not be operated upon any City street which is a primary road extension through the City but shall be allowed to cross a City street which is a primary road extension through the City. Primary road extensions are those streets that are also a State highway. Golf carts are also prohibited from traveling on any sidewalk. (Ord. 948 – Dec. 07 Supp.)

<u>77.04 EQUIPMENT</u>. Golf carts operated on City streets shall be equipped with adequate brakes, a slow moving vehicle sign, bicycle safety flag and such other safety equipment required by Chapter 321 of the Code of Iowa.

<u>77.05 HOURS.</u> Golf carts may be operated on City streets only between sunrise and sunset.
